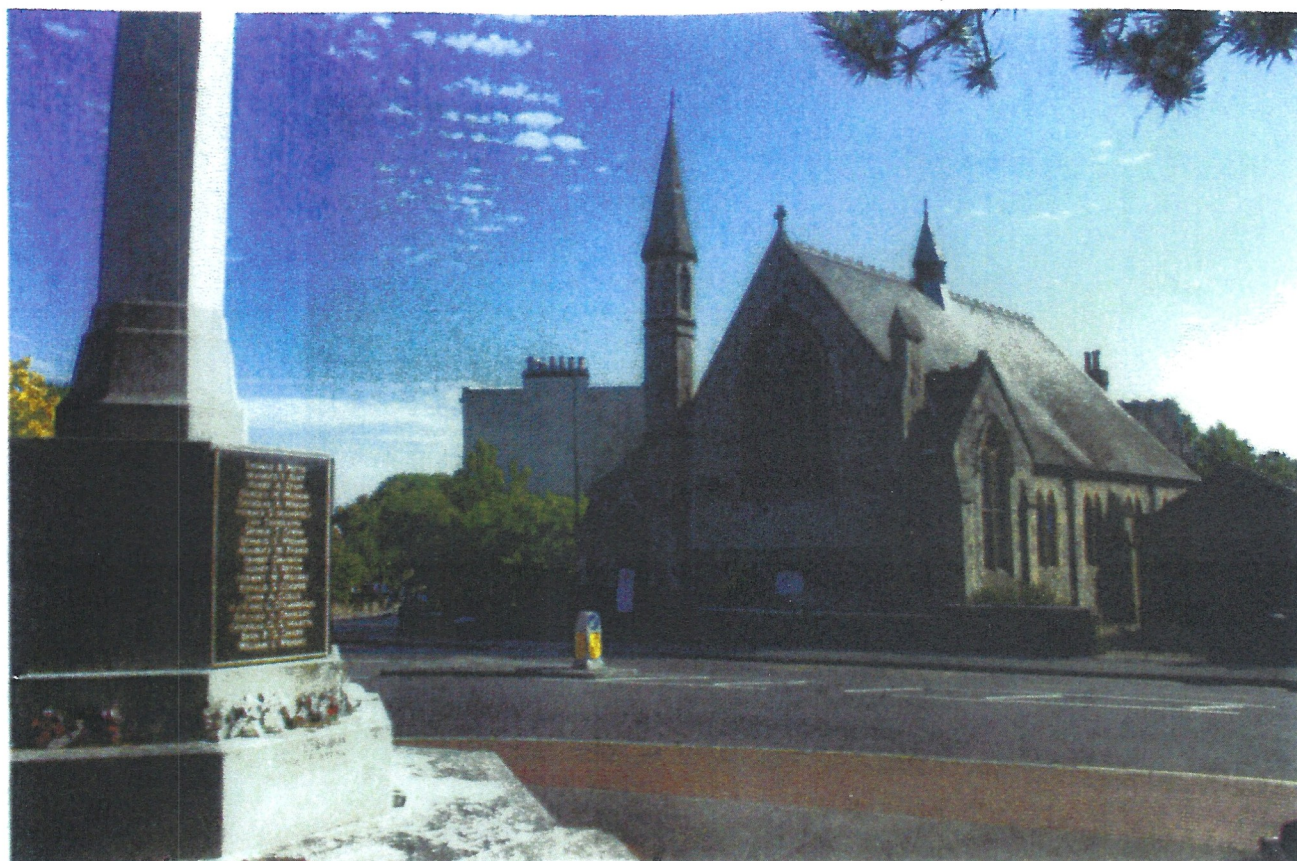

The United Reformed Church is one of the non-conformist, i.e. non-Catholic and non-Anglican, denominations of the Christian Church in the United Kingdom.

We have a group of Elders headed by the Minister, whose function is to guide and advise the church meeting; it also has oversight of the spiritual and pastoral life of the church.

We are a small friendly church in the centre of Bexley Village. Our outreach programme into the community is an important part of our work, with activities such as afternoon teas, exercise classes, monthly concerts and social activities. Our premises are used by a varied number of Groups – for example the Guides and Brownies, Ladies Groups, Knit & Natter, Whist Drives, Bexara, Yoga Club, Singing Group and Dance Group.
